Orv Watson Award

This award is given annually in recognition of an individual who has made an outstanding contribution to their profession, to the OACAS and to the community. The 2019 recipient was Erin Fitzgerald, Attendance Counsellor, Near North District School board. Deadline for nominations is February 01, 2021. Nominations can only be accepted by a current and active member of OACAS and the nominee must also be a current and active member of the OACAS.

Here's how you nominate- 1) submit a formal letter of nomination to the OACAS secretary- Marsha Sylvia - marsha.sylvia@ucdsb.on.ca that includes person or person(s) making the nomination (names, school boards, telephone numbers) and the individual being nominated by February 01. 2) Letters of support for the nomination for the Orv Watson award specifically (to be submitted after February 01)- Letters supporting the individual from a variety of sources which must include their contribution to the profession of Attendance Counselling, the past and/or present involvement with OACAS, present employer i.e. supervisor, superintendent and their community.

OACAS Certification

The criteria to receive such a certificate is....

- 1. A letter from your supervisor or superintendent, confirming that you have been in an Attendance Counsellor role for over a 2-year period,
- 2. Verification of the completion of the 2-day Attendance Counsellor course offered to all School Boards across Ontario by our OACAS counsellor instructors.
- 3. A copy of a degree or diploma in either child care or social service. And lastly...
- 4. You must be an active member of the Ontario Association for Counselling and Attendance Services (OACAS).

Email or mail all these documentations to Elisabeth.Hoskins@lkdsb.net and the committee will have all credentials reviewed. These certificates are only issued and presented yearly at our conferences, (whether virtual or face to face) however, if an individual is unable to attend our conference, following the conference, a certificate could be forwarded to your specific work place location.
